Volunteer non-fiction and creative editors

Right Now is a human rights media organisation. Our goal is to be a hub for Australian human rights news and analysis.

Editors are expected to have a clear grasp of the human rights debate in Australia. They should be confident in their ability to solicit topical and newsworthy content for the magazine.

Editors should also attend fortnightly editorial meetings and Right Now events.

Responsibilities include:

Commissioning

- Pitching ideas for the magazine.
- Identifying potential writers and commissioning new work.

Corresponding with authors (including staff writers)

- Work-shopping ideas with potential contributors.
- Cooperate professionally with authors and provide authors with constructive editorial feedback.

Editing

- Copyediting and structural editing.
- Proofreading—editing for spelling, grammar, etc.
- Finding feature images, writing headlines, and writing and optimising tags, excerpts and descriptions for SEO and digital media.

Publishing

- Uploading articles to the Right Now website, as directed by the Editor-in-Chief or Managing Editor.
