About the role:

Right Now's team of editors are responsible for its online magazine (<u>rightnow.org.au</u>). Reporting directly to the Editor-in-Chief, the **Managing Editor** manages Right Now's publishing activities and supervises our team of volunteer editors. The Managing Editor role is an exciting opportunity to be part of a growing independent media organisation. It is also a chance to develop your leadership skills and connect with likeminded individuals who are passionate about advancing the human rights conversation in Australia.

Key responsibilities:

- Supervise a small team of volunteer editors
- Oversee the editorial team's commissioning and editing tasks
- Manage Right Now's publishing schedule
- Format and schedule articles for publication using WordPress, which includes conducting picture research and writing headlines
- Pitch ideas, identify potential contributors and commission new content
- Edit content, including structural editing, copyediting and proofreading
- Collaborate professionally with contributors and provide constructive editorial feedback
- Together with the Editor-in-Chief, host fortnightly editorial meetings
- Serve as acting Editor-in-Chief of Right Now when required

Our ideal candidate is someone who:

- Has experience in, or a strong capacity to, manage a small team
- Knows how to write and edit engaging content for online audiences
- Has a keen eye for accuracy and detail, and can meet deadlines
- Is a news junkie with a clear grasp of Australian human rights issues
- Has relevant qualifications in law, social sciences, journalism or publishing
- Is self-motivated with an ability to work effectively with minimal supervision
- Is a wiz with WordPress and social media platforms (or has a willingness to learn!)
- Enjoys working in a collaborative team environment

Duration and time commitment:

This position requires a minimum 6 month commitment of approximately 5 hours per week.

About Right Now:

Right Now is a volunteer, not-for-profit media organisation focused on human rights issues in Australia. We are committed to covering human rights issues through accessible, creative and engaging online, print and radio media.
